The **Executive Track** of the **Texas A&M University Master of Health Administration (MHA) Program** is designed for working professionals seeking educational preparation for career advancement or enhanced leadership capabilities in health administration.

Earn the Texas A&M University MHA degree while working full-time.

The **Texas A&M University Executive Track MHA** matches the lifestyle of busy health care professionals:

- **Format:** Face-to-face class sessions meet one weekend each month
- **Location:** Courses are taught at the Texas Medical Center in Houston
- **Focus:** One 4-credit hour course at a time
- **Cohorts:** Students take all 12 courses together
- **Class size:** 10-20 students

Content & Courses

The **Executive Track MHA** curriculum spans both fundamental and contemporary topics in health administration. All courses emphasize the leadership skills and practices required to address the range of issues currently facing health organizations and their leaders.

With 12 courses over 24 months and small class sizes, students in the **Executive Track MHA** learn not only from faculty, but from each other, forming lasting networks. With cohorts starting in August, students complete one course every two months, allowing time to focus on learning in-depth course content.
